

Expanded view of Access



Most important (according to users) information is elevated on the top of the page, however since this is not very often needed (e.g. most of the time of the day Opening Hours is not useful) it is collapsed in drawers.

Whenever there is a Map, written directions may not be so useful

Bookmark and Share tools positioned in a place where it can be used consistently in other propositions too.


Carousel takes to a new page where the user can see a combined view of Lounge and User Generated photos (Olaptic example)

Expanded view of Opening Hours




Expanded view of Food & Drink




We should also consider the feasibility of linking to pdf downloads of menus or external website menu pages
